The Irish Georgian Society

Since its foundation some 50 years ago, the Irish Georgian Society has contributed very significantly to the salvation of many of Ireland's most important buildings and has developed into a society which addresses the many facets of architectural heritage conservation. Today, the Society is the principle national watchdog for Ireland's built heritage and, as such, has a valuable role to play in ensuring that conservation issues remain a high priority.

How have we been funded?

We have a loyal and, we hope growing, membership base in Ireland and a strong and supportive group of members in the US and the UK who raised most of the funds that enabled the Society to save important buildings like Castletown, Doneraile Court and Tailors' Hall and, more recently, helped with vital conservation works in Ledwithstown, Kilshannig, Barmeth Castle and many other architectural gems throughout the country.

Why we need a lottery

The IGS has to find additional funding sources if it is to continue to be a strong voice for conservation in Ireland. Membership subscriptions are not sufficient to cover costs. Furthermore, whilst essential for the Society's remit, money raised by our members in the US and the UK or received from government sources is usually targeted for specific buildings or projects.

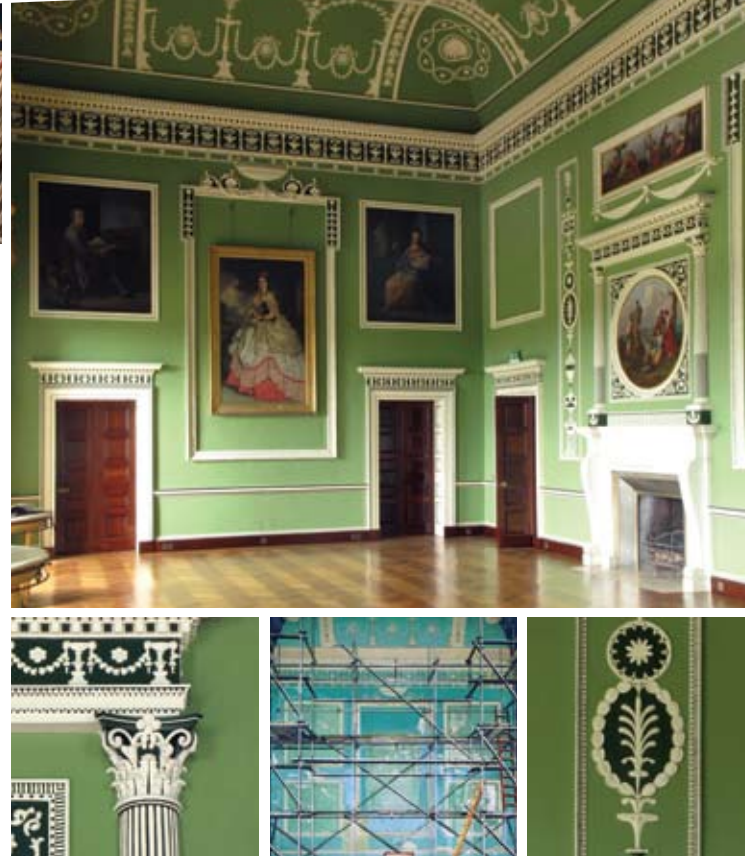


What We Do

The Society's work focuses on:

- Awarding conservation grants - since 2000, we have provided €1.2m of financial assistance for conservation and related projects.
- Promoting traditional building skills through exhibitions and our online register of practitioners and craftsmen.
- Seminars and conferences on conservation related topics.
- Campaigning for the preservation of our built heritage through lobbying and involvement in the planning process.
- Annually publishing *Irish Architectural and Decorative Studies: the Journal of the Irish Georgian Society*, Ireland's leading learned journal on architecture and the decorative arts.
- Providing an active membership programme that includes lectures, tours in Ireland and overseas, day trips to historic houses and holding special events in a variety of historic venues throughout the country.

All of these activities take **TIME** and **MONEY**.
